The school is a good example of the development of a school from 1861 onwards.</p> Criteria a) <p>Historical Significance</p> <p>The remaining two older School buildings - 1898 and 1900-1920 are typical examples of the typology of school buildings of the era. They have historic significance as a marker of the age and history of the school.</p> Criteria c) <p>Aesthetic/Technical Significance</p> <p>The school buildings are typical typologies of the school buildings provided throughout NSW in their respective era and enable an understanding of past schooling techniques.</p> Criteria d) <p>Social/Cultural Significance</p> <p>The School buildings are likely to have social significance to former students of the school and as part of the Colyton community for the past 100 years.</p> Criteria g) <p>Representative</p> |

Historical Notes or Provenance

Updated

Earlier buildings, no longer in existence, were built in 1861, and 1864. The first school at Colyton opened in 1861 in Simpson Hill Road. In 1864 the school was transferred to another building. In 1883 the location of the school was moved to its present site. The Brick building off Alan Street is likely to be one of the early buildings from the relocated school.

Further research is required into the history of Colyton Public School
