The building is a simple rectangular hall built mid to late 19th Century with colonial brick pattern, and narrow gothic style windows. The hall has an addition to the front (Mt Druitt Road) and rear c 1940's.

The central hall has a coffered ceiling which has been lined with fibre cement sheeting but would once have been timber lined.

The building shows evidence of substantial cracking.
