**Historical Significance**

The cottage is of historic significance to the Seven Hills / Parklea district as a settlement home associated with early farming interests in the area. In conjunction with the restored Exeter Farm Cottage the house provides a link back to the original settlement of the area.

The cottage is a typical mid Victorian farm cottage.

Mid Victorian homes are rare in the Blacktown LGS.
