The cottage is a typical working class Edwardian cottage, relating the subdivision of the Crawford's Hill End Estate in the early 20th Century (post 1912). The area is shown as continuing to be undeveloped at the time of the Bungarribee farms subdivision in 1912.

In 1914 the area is referred to as Doonside but still owned by the Crawford Family.

The railway first stopped at Doonside in 1880 known as Crawford's Siding. In 1921 it was first renamed Walkara, and then Doonside in the same year. It is likely that development along Hill End Road commenced around the opening of the railway station.
