Marayong Reservoir (WS 66) is a cylindrical reinforced concrete reservoir with stepped and tapered sides and a rib around the rim. The rim of the reservoir has a raised walkway the adjacent reservoir, Marayong Reservoir (WS 195).

Standard features include: concrete apron, depth gauge board, access stairway, handrails and inlet and outlet valve chambers.

Capacity: 9.1 ML.

Marayong Reservoir (WS 66) was completed in 1938. The remaining three reservoirs on the site were constructed after 1961. A new reservoir is under construction (2000) which will replace the existing reservoir. The number of reservoirs on the site indicates the vast increase in demand for the north western suburbs of Sydney since the 1960s.
