Significance

Statement Of Significance

The structure is a fine example of a late nineteenth century brick cottage with decorative cast iron detailing, that demonstrates a phase in the development of St Marys with the construction of outlying working class cottages. The building is one of a group of cottages on Pages Road which form a conspicuous element on the south western fringe of St Marys.

Criteria a)

Historical Significance

The cottage demonstrates a phase in the development of St Marys with the construction of outlying working class cottages presumably associated with the tannery industry.

Criteria c)

Aesthetic/Technical Significance

The cottage is a good example of a late Victorian vernacular house that retains, to varying degree, key characteristics such as roof, plan form and detailing.

Criteria g)

Representative

The building is one of a small number of structures in St Marys erected over the nineteenth century and early part of the twentieth century that demonstrate the evolution of a village settlement.

Physical Description

39 Pages Road is a late nineteenth century brick cottage with a steep pyramidal hipped roof sheeted in corrugated metal. The symmetrical front elevation is characterised by a verandah with bullnose profiled roof supported by timber posts with chamfered edges and decorative brackets. The façade treatment is characterised by a rough-cast wall surface and rendered quoins and window margins. The verandah, which is partially enclosed, returns on the side elevations. The cottage is set within a large block with mature garden which contributes to the setting of property. The cottage has frontage to Pages Road which with its irregular alignment evokes an early rural road. A sense of the original rural setting of the cottage is provided by the extensive neighbouring park reserves.
