Physical Description

No. 38 Gildey Street is a quaint late nineteenth century brick Gothick Revival cottage which is one of a pair of extant buildings of like design. The cottage has cement rendered external walls lined as ashlar masonry with vermiculated quoins, and moulded label moulds and window sills. The roof is half hipped with a gabled projecting wing sheeted in corrugated metal. The strongly defined roof form includes a brick chimney with corbelled capital. The gable has a finely fretted decorated bargeboard. The front verandah has a bullnose profiled roof supported on timber posts. There is an attached rear service wing. The cottage is set within a narrow and deep allotment close to the street boundary. The house is located in Gidley Street which is located to the west of the main commercial precinct of Queen Street. The house is part of a discrete unit in the St. Marys township area which is enhanced by the hilly setting on the group with outlook west to the Blue Mountains.
