## Significance

- Statement Of Significance**  
Originally associated with Andrew Thompson’s neighbouring Mimosa (1874), the stables are an excellent example of a late-Victorian rural outbuilding. With its sawn vertical slabs, the building is an unusual example of Victorian era vernacular building technology. The building is one of a number of structures in St Marys erected over the nineteenth century and early part of the twentieth century which collectively demonstrate the evolution of village settlement.
- Criteria a)**  
**Historical Significance**  
The former stables is associated with the neighbouring Mimosa and as such demonstrates the rise of a resident business class in St Marys over the late nineteenth century.
- Criteria b)**  
**Historical Association Significance**  
The property is associated with Andrew Thompson, the tanner of St Marys.
- Criteria c)**  
**Aesthetic/Technical Significance**  
The building is an excellent example of a late Victorian rural outbuilding, now highly visible due to its roadside location.

Criteria e)

Research Potential

The building utilises a construction technology which is indicative of the rural vernacular buildings of its era.

Criteria f)

Rarity

The building is an unusual example of Victorian era vernacular building technology within a suburban setting in the LGA.

Criteria g)

Representative

The building is one of a small number of structures in St Marys erected over the nineteenth century and early part of the twentieth century which collectively demonstrate the evolution of village settlement. These structures imbue the suburb with its historic and aesthetic values.

A later gabled weatherboard shed is attached on the western side. The building is slightly set back from the street.
