



Cambridge Gardens – Timeline

Cambridge Gardens is part of Phillip Parker King's 1831 land grant, St Stephens. Cambridge Park estate was subdivided in the 1880s. Cambridge Gardens was gazetted a neighbourhood of Cambridge Park in 1981, three years after a second primary school had been opened in the area and named Cambridge Gardens School.

1822		Phillip Parker King received a Ticket of Occupation over most of the 3000 acres reserved as a common for local farmers
1831		Phillip Parker King received a 1500 acre grant and named it St Stephens
1884	December	Cambridge Park estate was subdivided into farmlets
1981		Subdivision known as Cambridge Gardens was gazetted as a neighbourhood of Cambridge Park
1988	21 September	Centenary celebrations of Cambridge Gardens School
