Bullnose verandah across the front with hip corners and filigree lace. Painted brick chimney with steps with Chinese lantern pots. Property has been subdivided. Windows have painted rendered sills. Exterior doors: Transom light over three French doors with bolection mould panels below and glazed panels above flank front door. Fence is low timber paling fence with timber rail and matching gate. Main entrance door is Victorian, four panel, with upper panels glazed and timber risers within bolection moulded panels below.
