#### **Statement Of Significance**

Completed in 1878, Christ Church is unique in the area for its age and historical associations with Hadley Park and Nepean Park. The setting for the church demonstrates the continuation of a tradition of Anglican Church mission in the area since the 1810s and provides insight into the early community of the region. It is a picturesque landmark situated above the river plains with sight lines to historic homesteads in the valley.

#### **Physical Description**

Christ Church is a brick mid-Victorian Gothic Revival church set atop the escarpment above the Nepean River flood plain. The church comprises a nave and chancel with a porch on the north elevation. The external buttressed walls are rendered and read as stone, and there are rendered label moulds and lancet windows. The gabled roofs with end parapets are sheeted in corrugated metal. The church is to the south-east corner of the old Castlereagh township just beyond the original town plan in a sparsely settled area. This setting of the church ensures it is prominent from the river valley, where it is meant to be seen, and the riverside homesteads of Hadley Park and Nepean Park are visible from the church. The steep graded small church reserve is cleared. There is a typical rural earth closet at the rear of the church. A gravel path leads from Church Lane to the rise of the church.
