Attractively nestled on the crest of the rise to the east of Castlereagh Road, the item is a late Victorian brick farmhouse with a hipped roof. The building has a symmetrical front elevation with a bullnose profiled verandah, centred door and flanking sashed windows. Sited at the western end of Church Lane the cottage is orientated to face the valley of the Nepean River and Blue Mountains. The elevation of the house, its cleared paddock foreground and treed backdrop combine to provide a element which contributes to the overall setting of the escarpment.
