The memorial honouring the local residents who served in the first world war demonstrates familial associations with the local area and the location of the village centre at Upper Castlereagh in. The memorial in its scale, materials and stylistic traits evokes the era of dedication, and serves to inform the present community about past events of national and local significance. The memorial is part of a group of structures clustered at Upper Castlereagh erected over the nineteenth century which collectively demonstrate the pattern of a roadside village settlement. Collectively these structures imbue the area with high historic and aesthetic values.

The memorial demonstrates the emergence of a village centre at Upper Castlereagh in the late nineteenth century.

The war memorial demonstrates familial associations with the local area.

Social/Cultural Significance

Representative

The memorial in its scale, materials, stylistic traits and original purposes is representative of their eras. The memorial is part of a group of structures at Upper Castlereagh erected over the nineteenth century which collectively demonstrate the pattern of a roadside village settlement. <p>The item is a modest war memorial set within the grounds of the former public school. The war memorial to men from local families who served in World War One is a simple marble structure comprising a Classic style detailed stelae on a plinth. The roll of honour faces the road and the names are engraved in the lower part of the memorial. The placement of the memorial in the grounds of the former school evidently reflects the sense that this was considered the most prominent place within the village and the only publicly owned land.</p>
